

Cup Holder Mitten

Materials:

Cascade 220: size 8 circular needle (or dpns)
1 skein in each color of your favorite team
Team patch (optional)

Gauge: 16 sts = 3" in stockinette stitch

Cuff:

Cast on 40/44/48 sts using k1,p1 cast on.
Join being careful not to twist.
Mark beginning of the round.
Work in 1x1 rib for 2.5/3/3.5".

Palm:

K in the round for 2.5/3/3.5" to reach base of thumb.

Split compartments.

Knit 20/22/24 sts. Mark this as A.
Place next 20/22/24 sts on stitch holder.
Provisionally cast on 20/22/24 sts. Mark this as B.
Knit across the provisionally cast on sts.

Continue knitting in the round for 8/9/9.5" from the split.

Mark first 20/22/24 as C; second 20/22/24 as D.

After the last round, mark the first 22 sts (on same side as the split) as C and the last 22 sts as D.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail for weaving.

Put each side on 1 needle each.

Weave D to A and continuing to weave, join C to B.

Bottom

Pick up stitches along the bottom. The number of stitches should be divisible by 8.

For my mitten, I picked up 48 sts.

Rnd 2: (K4, k2tog) around. 8 sts decreased. (40 sts)

Rnd 3 and all odd-numbered rounds: K.

Rnd 4: (K3, k2tog) around. (32 sts)

Rnd 6: (K2, k2tog) around. (24 sts)

Rnd 8: (K1, k2tog) around. (16 sts)

Rnd 10: (K2tog) around. (8 sts)

Cut yarn; with yarn needle thread yarn through all the sts; pull tight and weave in end.
